
RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

New spices varieties.

The 21st State Seed Subcommittee Kerala approved for release and notification the ginger varieties "IISR Mahima" and "IISR Rejatha" as well as nutmeg variety "IISR Viswasree" from Indian Institute of Spices Research, Kozhikode.

Isolation of DNA from rhizomes of turmeric and ginger

Good quality DNA amenable to restriction digestion and PCR amplification was isolated from rhizomes of turmeric and ginger.

Plantlets were induced directly from pseudostem explants of ginger.

Paprika

Thirty five paprika accessions including 14 exotic and 21 indigenous lines were evaluated for their colour value and oleoresin. Crosses were made between Bydagi-types and two pungent exotic lines, Papriking, to combine the desired traits of the parental lines.

Cassia

Clonal progeny analysis of four cassia elite lines (A₂, C₁, D₁ and D₃), based on first coppicing (4 years after planting) indicated that there is no significant difference among them for bark yield.

Tree spices - Germplasm collection

Seven cultivated accessions of Garcinia gummiigutta, including one with about 235g fruit weight, was collected from Kozhikode and Kannur districts of Kerala. Two cultivated accessions of Kokam (G. indica) from Vengurla (Maharashtra) & Taliparamba (Kerala) were also collected and added to the conservatory. One accession of Syzygium cuminii var. gokad, six accessions of Myristica fragrans and two accessions of Cinnamomum verum were also collected from Vengurla (Maharashtra) and Kozhikode (Kerala).

Biocontrol research

Trichoderma isolates obtained from black pepper rhizosphere are maintained in the Repository. One hundred and twenty nine of these isolates were identified upto species level based on morphological characters.

Application of sorghum based formulation of *Trichoderma* in the field resulted in increased soil population of saprophytic mites and saprophytic nematodes.

Decomposed coir compost was found to be , good carrier medium for *Trichoderma*.

High myristicin and elemicin nutmeg lines

Myristicin and elemicin are the two hallucinogenic principles present in nutmeg (Myristica fragrans) and its mace. Few germplasm accessions available at Indian Institute of Spices Research, Kozhikode are found rich in mace oil and nutmeg oil with around 25-30% myristicin.

Recent studies have shown that myristicin is a potential anticancerous drug.

Management of root mealybugrecommendation approved


Infestation by the root mealybug (Planacoccus sp.) is becoming serious in recent years on black pepper especially in Wynad District of Kerala. Field trials conducted at Wynad district for the past 2 years indicated that among the various insecticides, chlorpyriphos (0.075%) was the

most effective and was on par with quinalphos (0.075%) and profenophos (0.075%). This finding was approved as a recommendation for extension agencies during the XV Annual Research Council Meeting of the Institute held during 4-6 April 2002.

SPICES GERMPLASM COLLECTION FROM PEPPARA & NEYYAR WILD LIFE SANCTURIES AND ACHAN KOVIL FORESTS

During November 11-18, 2002, IISR scientists Dr. B. Sasikumar and Mr. K.V. Saji explored the wild life sancturies of Peppara & Neyyar in Trivandrum district and Achan Kovil Forest range in Quilon/Pattanamthitta districts besides the Amboori tribal settlement belt in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.

A total of 79 specimens of Piper, Zingiber, Curcuma, Vanilla vatsalana, Garcinia gummi-gutta Cinnamomum sulphuratum were collected during the exploration.

The salient collections include a lone Piper hapnium (\$\frac{1}{2}\$) collection from amongst a sizeable female population in Achan Kovil forest range, a Zingiber sps. with the flavour of nutmeg rint and a Piper longum (\$\frac{1}{2}\$) accession with a slight pink coloured immature spikes.

A large population of Z. officinale and C. longa could be seen at Alappady Meth, 20 k.m. inside Achan Kovil forests. This may be a 'run wild' population escaped from the Malapandaram's hamlets. 'Malapandarams' are the native tribe of Achan Kovil region, inhabiting deep inside the forest.

The then Director, Dr. Y.R. Sarma, highlighted two major issues in chillies viz., the problem of aflatoxin and pesticides residues, in his welcome address.


Exporters, scientists and development officers deliberated on the production, quality and marketing aspects of the commodity.


RESEARCH ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING
