# From Director's Desk

Keeping in view the ICAR slogan "Farmer First" the institute made a vow about a year ago 'To make the technologies visible'. Subsequently, during the Institute Research Council Meeting held in April, a session with extension agencies was arranged and debated on the technologies ready for adoption in the field, viz., PGPR for growth promotion, nutrient mixtures for alleviating micronutrient deficiencies etc. It is now gratifying to note that IISR has made giant strides by developing technologies that are ready for licensing. Of course, the ball was set rolling when we successfully licensed our spice varieties. Due to intellectual property right (IPR) related issues, protection of technologies and varieties are a matter of great concern. IPRs are of course vital in a knowledge-based economy, because

they confer exclusive legal rights that can be used to prevent others from simply copying a technological innovation and free-riding on the back of someone else's research and development efforts. This was one major reason why ICAR constituted the Institute Technology Management Unit (ITMU) for the effective implementation of intellectual property protection of technologies developed at each of the ICAR institutes, with an Agricultural Technology Management Committee (ATMC) at New Delhi. Our foray into the world of commercialization and licensing of technologies would further inspire us to develop new and exciting technologies that benefit both the developer and the end user. The paradox about new technologies is that it will allow us to make more breakthroughs at a faster pace. Things that were once considered fiction are now becoming mundane occurrences. But what

at a faster pace. Things that were once considered fiction are now becoming mundane of matters is whether our products stand the test of time. Normally this can be ensured by either making small tweaks to the existing product/process or by improvising the existing technology to meet the ever increasing demand of the users. Tweaking an available product shows creativity, while a new product that changes the way farmers cultivate spices is both creative and innovative. Every new development, every new step up the scientific ladder leads to breakthroughs that make a technology sustain and evolve into new avatars that are tailor-made to meet specific conditions. Though it would appear clichéd, I once again reiterate that when we propose new projects we may keep in mind the possibility of developing new technologies/ products/ processes that are commercially viable and can be licensed to third parties. We are living in an exciting and exhilarating world of science and technology. So let us spawn new technologies and make product improvements with commercial implications that are game-changing.

# **Research Update**

# Effect of flowering on yield and quality of turmeric

Studies conducted in eleven varieties of turmeric viz., BSR-2, Duggirala Red, IISR Alleppey Supreme, IISR Kedharam, IISR Prathibha, Megha Turmeric-1, Narendra Haldi-1, Rajendra Sonia, Resmi, Roma and Suranjana during 2008-11, indicated that flowering did not have any influence on its yield and quality.

# Breeding cardamom for high yield and disease resistance

One hundred and fifty F2 mapping populations are being screened against *Katte* disease under glass house conditions.

# Location of *Piper yellow mottle virus* (PYMoV) in black pepper seeds

Studies conducted to know the location of *Piper yellow mottle virus* (PYMoV) in different parts of black pepper seed showed the presence of PYMoV in embryo, endosperm and perisperm in all the four varieties tested and the concentration of viral DNA was found to be almost same in all these parts.

# Transcriptome analysis of *C. amada - R. solanacearum* pathosystem

The transcriptome has been sequenced from rhizome tissue samples of *Curcuma amada* and *Zingiber officinale* after challenge inoculation with *Ralstonia solanacearum* using next generation technologies for short read (Illumina platform). It involves analysis of GC content, repeat content, putative functions, gene families, transcription factor encoding genes and comparative analysis between *C. amada* and *Z. officinale*. Several candidate genes coding for proteins related to stress and defense responses, such as glutathione-S-transferase, peroxidase, heat shock proteins, and lipoxygenase, that may underline the difference between *C. amada* and *Z. officinale* with regard to resistance to *R. solanacearum* have been identified.

Specimens of different species of *Garcinia*, available at National Herbarium, at Botanical Survey of India, Sibpur, Kolkata was digitized and was deposited at IISR Library.
